Parent Information Handout

- Dress Rehearsal: On Friday, April 11 at 6pm, sharp.
 - All Skaters must arrive at 530pm and head to their change room. Parents can put on the skaters skates and then leave with the room parents.
 - We also practice our finale number at the beginning of dress rehearsal. All Skaters should have their skates and costumes on, ready to start getting on the ice at 5:50pm.
 - Our PreCanSkate Chocolate Bar and Clean Up Crew will do their program at the beginning and will allowed to leave. Everyone else will run through the show in the correct order.
- Ice Show Day: On Saturday, April 12. Shows are 12:00(noon) and 6:00pm.
 - Skaters should be at the arena and in their change room for **11:30 am** and **5:30pm**.
 - There will be group parents to watch the skaters so we are asking that you drop your skater with them. Parents can stay to watch the show or come back at 1pm or 7pm. and go upstairs to watch the show (if you are staying).
 - **Skaters are expected to attend both shows.** The show should be 1 hr 30 mins to 2 hrs in length.

Positions Needed:

- Room Parent They are the ones that ensure that all the skaters have gone to the bathroom, have their costume on the right way, and that all the skaters are there for the group and make it to the ice. There will be coloring sheets and paper in the changerooms along with a table for the skaters to use for some entertainment. The parent room attendants do not need to pay for a ticket as you are volunteering your time. Groups can watch the show from the end stands and just need to be aware of when they need to be back in their rooms for performance.
- Setup: Helps setup of the props and others items on Friday, April 11th and after First Show.
- Cleanup: Completes take down and takes items back to storage.
- **Ticket Selling:** Taking and Selling Tickets at the Door. Required to man the door until after intermission.
- 50/50 Ticket Sales: Selling 50/50 tickets to the audience
- **Ice Captains:** Organizes groups/skaters to ensure they are ready to go and assist with getting on/off ice surface.
- **Music Player:** Playing the music when prompted by announcer. Should be able to attend the dress rehearsal on April 11.
- Announcer: Reads the story to the audience.
- **Spotlight Operators:** Operates spotlights. Must be able to stand for entire show.

• **Emergency Lights Operator:** This individual operates the emergency lights switch. This position must be filled!

Tickets!! Tickets are on sale through the website (www.ykskatingclub.ca) also at the door. Show Prices are: Children under 3 - Free, Youth 3 to 12years - \$5, Individuals over 12 - \$10. Tickets are required for admission, including children under 3 as it helps us track attendance.

There will be a 50/50 draw fundraiser and Carnations for purchase.
